• SS- Academic Achievement in Social Studies: The campus achieved the top quartile (top 25%) in relation to its campus comparison group on 50% or more (intermediate schools) or 33% or more (high schools) of their eligible measures in social studies.
• Ready- Postsecondary Ready: Elementary and Intermediate Schools must be in the top quartile of Campus Comparison Group on Index 4 score. High Schools must be in the top quartile of Campus Comparison Group on $\geq 33\%$ of the indicators for which the campus has data. The District earns a Postsecondary Readiness Distinction Designation if across all campuses in the district $\geq 70\%$ of the postsecondary readiness indicators are in the top quartile of the campuses' respective Campus Comparison Groups.
